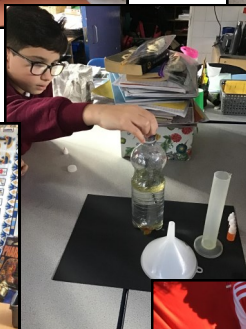
My Guy is also busy reading through the entries to our short story competition. He will be asking for support from School Council to help make the difficult decision of deciding on the winners.
