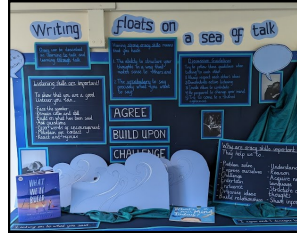

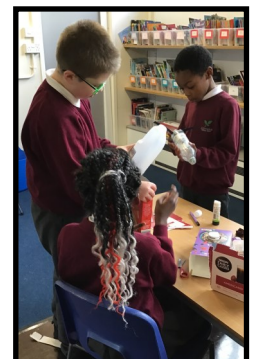
Please can we remind you to always inform us of any changes to your personal details, such as your address and telephone number. It is crucial that we have up to date details for you in case of an emergency.
